Entries accepted August 2 and 3, 2024. Entry fees: All exhibitors must purchase a membership or season ticket. Out of county sheep shall pay an entry fee of \$1.00 per head. All sheep need to be on grounds between 7pm - 8pm, Saturday prior to fair start and MUST be vet checked before being unloaded. Judging to be done Monday, before the Junior Fair Sheep Show. See general rules for further instructions. All sheep must have registration papers. Open class sheep may be removed from the grounds on Friday from 10am - 12 noon. If not removed during this time then animals must wait until all market animals are released after the sale on Saturday. All animals MUST be accompanied with a pink haul slip that will be disbursed at the Jr. Fair Office prior to removal from the grounds.

As a member of the livestock industry, exhibitors learn proper care and standards of the industry and complete a quality assurance certification. A Grand and Reserve Champion Markey Lamb will be chosen from among the exhibitors along with a Grand & Reserve Champion Showman. Market Lambs sell on Saturday.
