Camping Rules

- 1. The Meigs County Agricultural Society will provide up to 30 amp service at each camping location. Any alteration of this can cause you to lose your camping lot immediately and all future years.
- 2. Absolutely no wastewater is to be discharged from campers or tents. It must be held in an approved holding tank.
- 3. NO Campers on grounds <u>UNTIL 12 NOON SATURDAY</u>, <u>PRIOR TO FAIR</u> & must be removed by 12 Noon the following Sunday.
- 4. Pay Privilege & pick spot at fairgrounds on Saturday August 3, 2024 prior to fair. NO earlier. Must have photo ID.
- 5. Camping cost does not include entry onto the grounds.
- 6. You may reserve the same spot for next year if paid by close of fair on Saturday of fair. A refund may be requested before July 1, 2025. Only the person whose name is on the register may physically renew & must have photo ID.
- 7. Everyone over two (2) years of age staying in the camper must purchase a fair ticket.
- 8. Only one tent/camper per space.
- 9. 20 feet of width space is allotted to each camper. Awnings, tables, etc must be kept within assigned area.
- 10. Quiet hours begin at 12:30am. Please consider others. A disturbance may cause you to be evicted from the grounds.
- 11. The person whose name appears on the register **MUST** occupy camping spots.
- 12. YOU MAY NOT SUBLET YOUR SPOT. Any violations may cause you to lose your spot.
- 13. Pets must be on a leash if outside camper and you must clean up after your pets.
- 14. No pets permitted inside fenced fairgrounds (except Pet Show entries on day of show and must be on leash)

15. NO ALCOHOL OR DRUGS PERMITTED ON GROUNDS.

- 16. You **must** have a camper or tent on lot. Can NOT be used solely as a parking space.
- 17. NO campfires or open flames on grounds at any time.
- 18. NO ATVs, UTVs, golf carts or any other type of recreational vehicles are allowed on the grounds with out written permission of the Meigs County Agricultural Society.
- 19. ANY VIOLATION MAY CAUSE YOU TO LOSE YOUR SPOT.

Johnny on the Spot will be onsite providing sanitation services. Please see camping packet for details regarding getting your camper pumped.
