Dairy and Market Goat Projects consist of raising goats to standards of the industry. Exhibitors learn proper care and complete a quality assurance certification, DUNF form, project book judging, and other requirements by the Meigs County Agricultural Society and the Ohio Department of Agricultural. Market goats are required to weigh a minimum of 55 pounds. A grand and reserve champion market goat, along with grand/reserve showman will be selected among the exhibitors. Market goats will sell on Saturday, the auction will begin at 10am.

Breeding projects may be removed from the grounds Friday from 10am—12 Noon, or will need to wait until the close of the fair Saturday night. Every animals leaving the grounds will need to be accompanied with a pink slip that will be disbursed at the JR Fair Office.
