In the breeding and market rabbit show exhibitors will compete for Grand and Reserve Champion Showman, Best of Breed, Grand and Reserve Champion Market pen. The Market Rabbit project consists of feeding rabbits to a market weight minimum of 3.5lbs per rabbit. As a member of the livestock industry, exhibitors learn proper care and standards of the industry and complete a quality assurance certification. Market rabbits will sell on Saturday during the livestock sale. The sale begins at 10am.

Breeding projects may be removed from the grounds Friday from 10am - Noon, or will need to wait until the close of the fair on Saturday night. Every animal leaving the grounds will need to be accompanied with a pink slip that will be disbursed at the Jr Fair office.
