

**Jr. Fair Poultry Show**  
**Tuesday, August 12 2025 at 8am - Ridenour Livestock Arena**

The Meigs County 4-H Market Poultry & Breeding Poultry Show will be held on Tuesday, August 12 at 8 am in the Ridenour Livestock Arena. Showmanship classes will show first with market classes to follow.

Market poultry consists of feeding market chickens, turkeys, and/or ducks (purchased through the Meigs County Fair) to a minimum market weight. The market chicken project consists of two birds, each weighing 3 lbs minimum. The market turkey project consists of one bird weighing a minimum of 20 lbs. The market duck project consists of two birds, each weighing a minimum of 4.5 lbs.

As a member of the livestock industry, youth learn the same basic information as adults raising poultry. Exhibitors are required to complete quality assurance training, project book judging, DUNF form & any other paperwork as required by the Meigs County Agricultural Society & Ohio Department of Agriculture. A grand & reserve champion market chicken, turkey, & duck will be chosen from among the exhibitors along with a Grand & Reserve champion showman. Market poultry will sell on Saturday. The livestock sale begins at 10am.

Breeding poultry may be removed from the grounds on Friday from 10am - 12noon. If not removed during this time then must wait until all market animals are released on after the sale on Saturday. Every animal leaving the grounds will need to be accompanied with a pink haul slip that will be disbursed at the Jr Fair Office prior to removal from the grounds.
