- Membership shall consist of the following representation: 12 representatives from 4-H; 3 representatives from Jr. Grange, 3 representatives from Boy Scouts, 3 representatives from Girl Scouts, 3 representatives from Meigs FFA, 3 representatives from Southern FFA, 3 representatives each from any other youth organization that participates in the Meigs County Junior Fair. Please list above ALL of the organizations that you are a member of.
 - It will be the responsibility of each organization to fill the available positions on the Junior Fair board. If any organization cannot fill a position it may become available for another organization to fill its spot.
- Members will be chosen according to their completed application and an interview by the Senior Fair Board. Jr. Fair Coordinator, Amanda Faulk will contact you with interview date and time (*dress school appropriate ex. jeans and a nice shirt*). Unable to attend, could result in not getting a position on the board. Past members will also be chosen based on a satisfactory completion of the previous year.

- This application must be filled out by the representative running for the Junior Fair Board Position.
