

MARKET LAMB RULES: (4-H Project Book #198)

1. All market lambs must be slick sheared within one (1) week prior to Fair.
2. All market lambs must have a scrapie tag from the seller of the animal – USDA FARM TAG. We will not tag or weight without.
3. All market lambs must be born after January 1, 2026.
4. Market lambs can be ewes or wethers.

SHEEP BREEDING CLASSES AND RULES: (4-H Project Book #199)

1. Breeding entries will be shown in the following classes: *Suffolk, Hampshire, Crossbred, and any other recognized breed of sheep*

Ewe, Spring lamb	Born between January 1, 2026 and May 1, 2026
Ram, Spring lamb	Born between January 1, 2026 and May 1, 2026
Yearling ewe	One year and under two years
Yearling ram	One year and under two years
Ewe	Over two years
Ram	Registered, over two years

2. All breeding lambs must have a scrapie tag from the seller of the animal – USDA FARM TAG
3. There is no limit to the number of classes you enter, but you can only have one entry per class.
